Congratulations to all WCB suppliers recognised in the 2018 Dairy Australia Milk Quality Awards presented for achieving a place in the lowest consistent 5% BMCC results.

Fifty-three WCB suppliers were named in the awards list and of these twenty-three were in the top one-hundred in the competition. This is an excellent achievement!

The selection process is run by Dairy Australia completely independent of all milk processors. Suppliers with consistently low BMCCs rightfully deserve recognition. It indicates care and attention to cow health and good mastitis control techniques for the whole year. Victorian suppliers will have received their Dairy Food Safety Victoria (DFSV) farm licences recently. These should be kept in a safe place and will need to be produced at your scheduled food safety audit.
